The purpose of data processing is: to conclude and perform an agreement with the Data Controller, to provide services covered by the agreement, to handle payments and settlements (including issuing VAT invoices), to archive data and documents, to respond to letters, requests, complaints, to determine, defend and pursue possible claims.
- 3. You have the right to request access to and rectification, erasure or restriction of processing of your data, as well as the right to object to the processing of your personal data. You always have the right to withdraw your consent. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing of your data prior to the withdrawal of consent. If you have doubts as to whether your data is processed lawfully, you may lodge a complaint to the supervisory authority the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
- 4. Provision of data is voluntary, but necessary to fulfil the purposes specified in item no. 2. If the data are not provided, it will not be possible to conclude and perform the agreement.
- 5. The data provided by you will be shared with the following categories of recipients:

 - banks,
 - economic information bureaus and credit information bureaus,
 - law firms,
 - insurance companies,
 - tax offices,
- entities or bodies authorised under the law (including courts, prosecutors, bailiffs, regulatory and supervisory bodies).
- 1. The data provided by you will not be subject to profiling.
- 2. The data controller has no intention to transfer personal data to a third country or international organisation.
- 3. The personal data will be stored for the period necessary to fulfil the purposes of the concluded agreement and, after its termination, until the statute of limitations for claims to or against the Data Controller.
